The Texas Legislature is in session. Keep your eyes on these disaster relief bills:


- The Senate Water & Rural Affairs Committee unanimously passed the Senate's package
 of disaster relief bills on Thursday as committee substitutes. The bills have been placed
 on the full Senate's Intent Calendar for next week.
- SB 6 (Sen. Lois Kolkhorst) Creates a disaster response plan for local elected officials.
- SB 7 (Sen. Brandon Creighton) –Creates a "resiliency fund" to finance flood mitigation projects.
- **SB 8** (Sen. Charles Perry) Creates a statewide flood plan coordinated by the Texas Water Development Board.
- These are three of Lt. Governor Dan Patrick's priority bills among <u>his list of 30 priorities</u> for the 86th <u>Texas Legislature</u>.
- Your HAR Governmental Affairs team is actively monitoring all legislative developments and will continue to provide updates.


Weekly Market Movements

New listings and overall housing inventory are still proceeding slower than last year in many markets across the U.S., and they are mostly trailing activity for last year, which was already rather low. Sales have also been slower than last year at this time in areas with lingering winter weather, but the thaw is on. That may present a new set of difficulties for communities that have experienced an abundance of rain and snow over the last few months.

In the Houston region, for the week ending March 10:

- New Listings increased 6.8% to 3,225
- Pending Sales increased 18.2% to 2,193
- Closed Sales decreased 6.7% to 1,350
