Weekly Market Movements

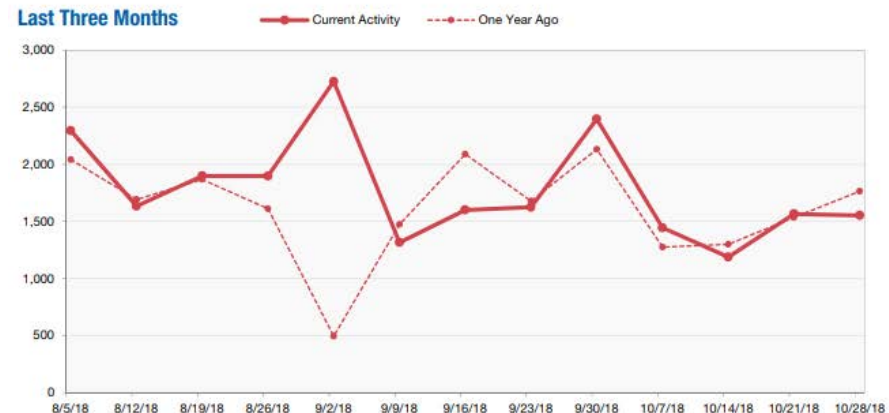
