Ponying Up for Protection

- Despite concerns about climate change and a recent study claiming that about \$450 billion of U.S. housing stock is at risk of flooding by 2050, less than 20 percent of American homeowners are willing to pay higher insurance premiums to protect their homes. That is one of the findings of a new survey.
- ValuePenguin recently surveyed 1,070 homeowners, and 47 percent said they are worried about having enough insurance to protect their homes from a climate change-induced natural disaster.
- However, 42 percent of homeowners said they are unwilling to pay higher insurance costs as the average monthly premium has risen to \$1,083 approximately 3.4 percent of a homeowner's annual income.

- For homeowners willing to shell out more, only 18 percent said they'd tack an extra \$500 to their bill.
- The ValuePenguin survey found that a whopping 60 percent of homeowners said premiums will become more expensive over the next five years, especially in low-lying and coastal areas vulnerable to flooding and hurricanes.
- ValuePenguin also questioned non-homeowners, and 66 percent said climate change had not affected their buying plans.
