#### **HAR's Coronavirus Preparedness**

In light of the global coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic, HAR has taken steps to protect our members and staff and to maintain continuity of service. We have compiled the following information from various sources to help answer some of the questions that have been asked by members. We will continue to keep you updated and advised as more information becomes available.

There will be no in-person HAR educational classes from Wednesday, March 18 through the end of April 2020. This may be extended as more information becomes available. If you are already scheduled to take an HAR class, you may cancel with no penalty. We are currently working on various alternatives to in-person classes and meetings.
