Coronavirus and Struggling Energy Strain Houston Housing in May

HAR released **May 2020** MLS statistics last week. Here are key take-aways from our latest **Market Update**:

Single-family home sales fell for the second straight month, down 20.2 percent versus May of 2019. Sales of homes priced from \$750,000 and up sustained the greatest losses, dropping 56.3 percent.



- Single-family home prices saw their first decline since January 2018. The average price fell 7.4 percent to \$298,199 while the median price was statistically flat at \$249,000
- Inventory registered a 3.5-months supply versus 4.1 months a year earlier. NAR reports that the national housing inventory stands at a 4.1-months supply.
- Townhome and condominium sales plunged 36.0 percent yearover-year.
- Single-family home leases were a bright spot, jumping 11.9 percent, while leases of townhomes and condominiums fell 4.6 percent.
