## **ARMs Are Back, But Not as You Remember Them**

- Adjustable-rate mortgages (ARMs), which start out with a relatively low rate that jumps after a certain time period, comprised nearly 11 percent of mortgage applications last week, the highest level since 2008, according to data from the Mortgage Bankers Association (MBA).
- This is another way that rate hikes by the Federal Reserve are changing markets and behavior.
- Until recently, 30-year fixed mortgage rates were super low. It didn't make sense to take on a riskier adjustable loan, or ARM. Now with rates on fixed loans up at around 5.5 percent, and ARMs often coming in at more than a point less, borrowers are going for it.
- A popular ARM now is the 5/6, according to Greg McBride, chief financial analyst at Bankrate.com. It's a fixed rate for five years, then adjusts every six months after that.


