


Week 23 2023: 6/6/2023 to 6/12/2023

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New Listings


New listings trailed 2022 numbers by 12.2 percent during the week ending June 12. REAL-TORS® entered 3,302 properties into the Multiple Listing Service (MLS) compared to 3,759 in the same week last year.


Pre-Pandemic: New listings are 6.9 percent behind Week 23 of 2019 when REALTORS® entered 3,547 properties into the MLS.



Pending Listings

Pending listings continue to lag behind 2022 levels. A total of 2,476 property listings went under contract compared to 2,677 in Week 23 of 2022. That is a decline of 7.5 percent. **Pre-Pandemic:** Pending listings were statistically flat when compared to the same week in 2019 when 2,469 property listings went under contract.






Off-Market Listings

Sellers withdrew more property listings from the MLS during the week ending June 12. Off-market listings were 19.9 percent above where they were last year at this time. A total of 1,141 homes went from active to off-market compared to 952 last year.

Pre-Pandemic: Sellers withdrew 20.3 percent fewer listings from the MLS during the same time period in 2019 when 1,432 homes went off-market.


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Closings

Single-family home closings decreased during Week 23. On a year-over-year basis, closed sales of homes were down 13.1 percent with closed sales totaling 1,870 versus 2,153 last year.

Pre-Pandemic: Closings are down 6.7 percent compared to Week 23 of 2019 when 2,004 units sold.




Showings

Consumer traffic at property showings throughout the greater Houston area was ahead of 2022 levels. Year-over-year attendance at Houston-area showings was up 16.2 percent for the week ending June 12. Showings volume totaled 47,147 compared to 40,588 for the same time last year. **Pre-Pandemic:** Property showings are up 12.7 percent compared to the same week in 2019 when property showings totaled 41,836.
