


Weekly Activity Snapshot

Week 28 2023: 7/11/2023 to 7/17/2023

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Statistics are for the Houston MSA.



New Listings

New listings remain down from 2022 levels. During Week 28, REALTORS® entered 3,266 properties into the Multiple Listing Service (MLS) compared to 3,686 last year. That is a decline of 11.4 percent.

Pre-Pandemic: New listings were down 8.3 percent compared to Week 28 of 2019 when RE-ALTORS® entered 3,563 properties into the MLS.





Pending Listings

Pending listings have almost caught up to 2022 levels. A total of 2,412 property listings went under contract during Week 28 versus 2,418 during the same week last year. That is statistically flat.

Pre-Pandemic: Pending listings were down 7.9 percent compared to 2019 when 2,620 property listings went under contract.







Off-Market Listings

Sellers withdrew more property listings from the MLS during the week ending July 17 than in 2022. Off-market listings rose 6.3 percent with a total of 1,260 homes going from active to off-market compared to 1,185 last year.

Pre-Pandemic: Sellers withdrew fewer property listings versus Week 28 of 2019 when off-market listings totaled 1,592 – a decrease of 20.8 percent.

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

Closings

Single-family home closings remain slightly behind 2022's volume. During Week 28, a total of 1,844 units sold compared to 2,005 in 2022. That is down 8.0 percent and marks the 28th consecutive weekly decline.

Pre-Pandemic: Closings were down 7.8 percent versus the same week in 2019 when a total of 2,000 units sold.

Showings

Showings are holding solidly above 2022 levels. During Week 28, there were 45,262 showings compared to 39,140 the same week last year. That is up 15.6 percent.

Pre-Pandemic: Property showings were up 9.2 percent compared to Week 28 of 2019 when consumer traffic totaled 41,460.
