




# **New Listings**

New listings topped 2023 levels for the fifth consecutive week. During the week ending May 6, REALTORS® entered 3,736 properties into the Multiple Listing Service (MLS) compared to 3,218 during the same time last year. That is up 16.1 percent.

# Pending Listings


During Week 18, pending listings were down 2.3 percent year-over-year. A total of 2,556 property listings went under contract compared to 2,616 during the same time last year.


### **Off-Market Listings**

Sellers withdrew significantly more property listings from the MLS during the week ending May 6. Off-market listings increased 55.5 percent year-over-year with 1,955 homes going from active to off-market compared to 1,257 last year.



# Closings

Closed sales of homes rebounded during Week 18, up 28.2 percent yearover-year. Closed sales totaled 2,362 compared to 1,842 last year.



## Showings

For the second consecutive week, consumer traffic slowed at property showings. During Week 18, year-over-year attendance at showings was down 8.9 percent. Showings volume totaled 42,369 compared to 46,508 at the same time last year.
