### Key takeaways from the **September 2025 HAR Market Update**:

- The Greater Houston housing market moved toward balance in September, with steady demand, easing prices and a robust supply of homes.
- Single-family home sales rose 5.3%, marking the fifth consecutive month of year-over-year growth.
- Active listings are still higher than this time last year, though month-to-month growth has begun to flatten.
- Months of inventory dipped slightly from August as a result of increased sales activity.

### What the Government Shutdown Means for Real Estate

Every day the federal government shutdown continues, the housing market—which accounts for nearly 20% of the U.S. economy—feels the effects.

- **NFIP Impact:** The National Flood Insurance Program cannot sell new or renewal flood insurance policies. Existing policies remain in effect until their expiration date, and claims will continue to be paid as long as FEMA has funds.
- Closings: Buyers may still assume existing policies, but new transactions in flood zones could face delays if insurance is required.
- Lending Flexibility: Regulators often allow lenders to move forward in flood zones, but policies may differ.
